INJECTION AREAS



Remember to always rotate your injection site. you have the correct insulin bottle Avoid injecting in scar tissues or in muscles.

Check the insulin bottle to make sure type of insulin.



For cloudy insulin, gently roll the between the palms of your hands.



Pick up the syringe and remove the needle cap.



Wipe the top of the bottle with an alcohol swab.



Insert the needle through the rubber top of the bottle.



Hold the insulin bottle firmly on a counter or tabletop.



Hold the syringe upright and pull the plunger back until it is at the number of units you need.



Push the plunger down so that the air goes into the bottle.



Turn the bottle and syringe upside down. Draw up the correct amount of insulin.



Remove the syringe from the bottle.



Put the needle fully through the skin at a 45 degree angle, depending on the skin depth.



Push down the plunger with your thumb to inject the insulin.

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When your sharps container is 3/4 full, bring it back to your pharmacy or your CLSC.
