

INTRODUCTION

Penile injections are the most reliable and effective treatment for erectile dysfunction.




- **Blood vessels:** The blood vessels are a system of tubes that deliver blood to the corpora cavernosa.
- 2 Corpora cavernosa: These 2 columns of spongy tissue run along the sides of the penis. Blood fills this tissue to cause an erection.
- **Nerves:** The nerves in the penis send signals to the brain, which in turn, sends signals to the blood vessels of the penis to expand for an erection.
- **Urethra or urinary canal:** This is another tube that runs through the penis. It acts as a passage for urine and semen.


WHAT IS PENILE INJECTION TREATMENT?

- It is a way of having an erection by injecting a medication into the penis.
- This medication allows more blood flow into the penis to produce an erection.
- The 2 possible side-effects are bruising and priapism (an erection lasting more than 4 hours). Both will be explained further on in the booklet.
- Orgasm and ejaculation are not changed by this treatment.

WHAT HAPPENS WITHIN 15 MINUTES OF AN INJECTION?



SUPPLIES NEEDED



• Since the medication is only available at a few pharmacies, we will tell you where to buy it. The pharmacy will supply you with everything you need.

WHAT TO DO WITH YOUR USED NEEDLES

- Ask your pharmacist for a special container for used needles.
- When the container is almost full, bring it back to your pharmacy.



STORING YOUR MEDICATION


- The medication must **always** be refrigerated but **never** frozen, otherwise it will lose its strength.
- The medication is good for 4 months when properly stored.
- At home, you may want to have one syringe filled and ready in the fridge. Before you use it, make sure that the amount of medication in it is still correct.



HOW TO PREPARE YOUR MEDICATION



Always use a new syringe and needle. If at any point during the procedure the needle touches something, throw it away. Start over with a new syringe and needle.



Your starting dosage is:






Wash your hands with soap and water.




Remove the cap from your medication vial.




Wipe the top of the rubber stopper with an alcohol swab.


HOW TO PREPARE YOUR MEDICATION






Hold both the syringe and the vial using both hands. Turn it upside down.












HOW TO INJECT


In order to be effective, the medication needs to be injected into a corpus cavernosum

Area of injection




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
If you are not circumcised, pull back your foreskin.



Using your thumb and forefinger, hold the head of your penis. Stretch your penis sideways so that it lies over your right or left thigh.



Wipe the injection site with an alcohol swab.



Remove the cap from the needle.




Place your penis as described above. Hold the syringe like a pen and insert the needle at a 90° angle.




Press the plunger with your thumb and slowly inject the medication.

HOW TO INJECT





9 Using your thumb, on the alcohol swab, press on the injection site for 5 minutes to prevent bruising.





Now you can start foreplay. Your erection should develop naturally in a comfortable, romantic environment.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

WHAT TO REMEMBER

• DO NOT use this injection more than 3 times per week.

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Always change the side and site of injection to prevent scarring of the penis.

- DO NOT inject into any visible veins as you may have some pain and/or bruising at the injection site.
- **DO NOT** inject the medication into the urethra. If you do, you may feel some burning and/or pass small amounts of blood the next time you urinate.
- DO NOT inject into an erect or semi-erect penis.
- **DO NOT** re-inject the same day. If you are not satisfied with your erection, you must still use the same dose at least 2 more times. Then, you can increase the dose by 2 units. You must also try this new dose at least 3 times total before you increase it again.


IMPORTANT INFORMATION

PROLONGED ERECTION (PRIAPISM)

Priapism is an erection lasting more than 4 hours. This can cause permanent damage to your penis.

If your erection lasts more than 2 hours, you should:

- 1. Stop all sexual stimulation.
- 2. Apply cloth-covered ice packs on and off.
- 3. If this does not work, go to your nearest emergency department. You should arrive no later than 3 hours after your injection. The team needs time to treat you before permanent damage can happen. Ask to see the "Urologist on call."


